| Baltimore City | Superfresh Supermarket (Pratt Street Meat and Produce Inc) | Baltimore     | \$110,000 | Expansion of produce inventory, a dedicated healthy food aisle, in-store displays, and nutrition education programming to increase fresh food access at this full-service city grocery.                 |
| Baltimore City | Farm Alliance of Baltimore, Inc.                           | Baltimore     | \$106,250 | Construction of a permanent 480 sq ft timber-frame farm stand at the Black Butterfly Teaching Farm in Curtis Bay, with refrigeration, SNAP/EBT, and produce sourced from urban growers.                 |
| Baltimore City | Acres4Change                                               | Baltimore     | \$100,000 | Infrastructure expansion at the Sankofa Micro-Farm Collective and Charm City Caps mushroom enterprise, including hoop houses, cold storage, and SNAP/EBT systems in Southwest Baltimore.                |
| Baltimore City | Civic Works, Inc.                                          | Baltimore     | \$76,000  | Establishment of a Sari-Sari-style nonprofit food store in a restored historic firehouse in Coldstream Homestead Montebello, adding refrigerated staples to an existing fresh produce program.          |
| Baltimore City | Mini Market Latino LLC                                     | Dundalk       | \$50,000  | Commercial refrigeration upgrades and expanded healthy food inventory to improve fresh food access at this Dundalk neighborhood grocery serving Latino and broader communities.                         |
| Calvert        | Chesapeake's Bounty (Tides and Turf LLC)                   | Saint Leonard | \$91,400  | Electrical infrastructure upgrades, refrigeration equipment, and SNAP/EBT technology at a local food market sourcing from Maryland farmers and Chesapeake Bay watermen.                                 |
| Carroll        | Georgia Belle Farms LLC                                    | Westminster   | \$45,000  | Walk-in cooler, refrigerated produce displays, and SNAP/EBT systems to expand cold storage and improve year-round fresh food access at this small Carroll County farm market.                           |
| Cecil          | Flying Plow Farm & CSA (The Flying Plow, LLC)              | Colora        | \$150,000 | Refrigerated delivery vehicle and walk-in cooler/freezer for self-service pickup to expand CSA distribution; Cecil County's only farm retailer accepting SNAP, WIC, and FMNP.                           |
| Charles        | Cobb Island Public Market (Panay LLC)                      | Cobb Island   | \$150,000 | Expansion into an adjacent 1,200 sq ft space with new refrigeration, HVAC, and fresh food infrastructure at the primary grocery serving this geographically isolated southern Charles County community. |
| Charles        | Oreofe International Food Market LLC                       | Waldorf       | \$150,000 | Energy-efficient refrigeration, a dedicated "Fresh Zone" for produce, and expanded fresh and locally sourced food inventory at this Waldorf neighborhood grocery and SNAP-authorized retailer.          |
| Charles        | La Bendicion Market (Suitland Grocery Store Inc.)          | Waldorf       | \$50,000  | Commercial refrigeration, healthy food inventory expansion, and SNAP/EBT POS upgrades to increase fresh produce, dairy, and meat availability at this St. Charles neighborhood grocery.                 |
| Charles        | Diamond International Mart                                 | Waldorf       | \$45,000  | Purchase of cold rooms, a delivery van, pallet rack, and forklift to expand fresh produce wholesale capacity and local delivery at this Waldorf neighborhood grocery.                                   |
| Charles        | Oasis Fresh Foods Market                                   | Indian Head   | \$41,000  | WIC-compatible POS upgrade and SNAP system improvements at an independent grocery serving military families and residents in western Charles County since October 2024.                                 |
| Charles        | Shlagel Farms LLC                                          | Waldorf       | \$25,000  | Expanded commercial refrigeration, updated produce displays, certified scales, and mobile POS registers to improve fresh food retail at this year-round on-farm market in Charles County.               |

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| Dorchester      | Simmons Center Market Inc.                          | Cambridge       | \$149,000 | Roof replacement, window replacement, and HVAC installation in a historic 1937 building to stabilize temperature control and protect fresh food inventory at this Cambridge neighborhood market.    |
| Dorchester      | Emily's Produce                                     | Cambridge       | \$72,000  | Delivery vehicle, point-of-sale systems, and produce handling equipment to expand CSA, Healthy Harvest, and Supper Club programs serving Dorchester County communities since 1998.                  |
| Dorchester      | Elijah's General Store                              | Toddville       | \$69,000  | Refrigeration units, shelving, and SNAP/EBT capability at a small rural grocery that serves as a key food access point for residents in the isolated Toddville area.                                |
| Frederick       | Veggie Van Mobile Market - Farm to School Frederick | Frederick       | \$150,000 | Retrofit of a commercial vehicle into a walk-on mobile market with refrigeration, shelving, and SNAP/EBT to bring locally grown produce to the Route 40 corridor in Frederick County.               |
| Frederick       | Nelia African Market                                | Frederick       | \$65,000  | Commercial refrigeration, freezers, and staffing for expanded fresh and culturally relevant Caribbean and African food products at this 6,000 sq ft specialty grocery in Frederick County.          |
| Frederick       | Asian Supermarket (Moe's Family LLC)                | Frederick       | \$35,000  | Energy-efficient refrigeration, working capital, and SNAP/EBT upgrades to expand fresh Southeast Asian produce and culturally relevant healthy foods at this Frederick grocery and bubble tea shop. |
| Garrett         | ALL Produce & Greenhouse                            | Oakland         | \$47,250  | New insulated year-round market building, refrigeration, and SNAP/EBT technology to expand fresh food retail at this family farm market serving a high-gap rural area of Garrett County.            |
| Garrett         | Three Sisters Farm                                  | Accident        | \$33,000  | Walk-in freezer, merchandising refrigerators, shelving, and SNAP/EBT equipment to complete an on-farm retail space serving Accident and surrounding rural Garrett County communities.               |
| Garrett         | Appalachian Farm & Food Alliance, LLC               | Oakland         | \$25,000  | SNAP/EBT infrastructure and working capital to support year-round operations at the Mountain Fresh Farmers Market pavilion in Oakland, Garrett County.                                              |
| Harford         | Daily Crisis Farm                                   | White Hall      | \$49,518  | Grant funds enable Daily Crisis Farm to purchase a refrigerated transport vehicle to transport their dairy products to their farm market and local retailers.                                       |
| Kent            | Fresh Start Food and Garden LLC                     | Rock Hall       | \$62,000  | Walk-in cooler expansion, additional retail freezers, and store AC to expand fresh local produce and frozen meat storage at this Rock Hall market where 50-60% of produce is Eastern Shore-sourced. |
| Kent            | Red Acres Hydroponics LLC                           | Worton          | \$43,000  | Farm store expansion from 260 to 600 sq ft with additional refrigeration, display tables, freezer, SNAP/EBT POS, and wheelchair-accessible entry at this sixth-generation Century Farm.             |
| Prince George's | Miller Farms (Miller Farm Produce Market, LLC)      | Clinton         | \$120,000 | Electrical infrastructure upgrade and ice machine installation to improve cold chain integrity and expand fresh produce storage at this Clinton on-farm market and regional distribution hub.       |
| Prince George's | The Capital Market                                  | Capitol Heights | \$106,000 | Buildout of the BlueLine AgriHub (food processing and commercial kitchen space), outdoor refrigeration units, and market trailer for this year-round BIPOC-focused farmers market organization.     |
| Prince George's | Sennel Gardens                                      | Capitol Heights | \$95,000  | Launch of the Seat Pleasant Farmers Market, farm infrastructure (hoop house, irrigation, wash station), SNAP/EBT systems, and beginner farmer training in Prince George's County.                   |
| Prince George's | Deep Roots Farm LLC                                 | Upper Marlboro  | \$92,000  | Shipping container storage hub, vendor tent systems, and communications equipment to strengthen the LovemyLargo Farmers Market as a fresh food anchor at this Black woman-owned regenerative farm.  |
| Queen Anne's    | Hunter's Seafood and Market                         | Grasonville     | \$150,000 | Expansion into an adjacent 2,650 sq ft building for a full-service market with produce, dairy, and staples, plus conversion of the existing building into a shared-use commissary kitchen.          |

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| Queen Anne's | Centreville Farmers' Market                                        | Church Hill    | \$50,000  | Establishment of two satellite market hubs with site preparation, electrical, a community garden, and SNAP/EBT access to reduce transportation barriers in rural Queen Anne's County.               |
| Somerset     | Becky's Market (Becky's Tropical & International Food Market, LLC) | Princess Anne  | \$135,500 | Roof repair/replacement, insulation upgrades, and a walk-in cooler to stabilize interior temperatures and protect perishable inventory at this SNAP-authorized family grocery in Princess Anne.     |
| Somerset     | Crisfield Area Chamber of Commerce and Visitor Center              | Crisfield      | \$39,500  | Creation of a "Local Food Marketplace" at the Crisfield Chamber with refrigeration, shelving, SNAP/EBT POS, and hydroponic towers to connect watermen and farmers directly to residents.            |
| St. Mary's   | Lyon Family Farms LLC                                              | Mechanicsville | \$100,000 | Renovation of a historic tobacco barn into a climate-controlled farm retail space with SNAP/EBT capability, centralizing sales for this 25-year-old direct-to-consumer farm operation.              |
| St. Mary's   | Russell Brothers Farm                                              | Morganza       | \$37,000  | Walk-in freezer and SNAP/EBT equipment to expand storage and fresh food retail at this fourth-generation family farm market serving approximately 100 families per week in rural St. Mary's County. |
| Washington   | Horizon Goodwill Industries                                        | Hagerstown     | \$150,000 | Final buildout and equipment (POS systems, checkstands, shopping carts, sprinkler upgrades) to open Horizon Market, a nonprofit full-service grocery in a Hagerstown food desert.                   |
| Washington   | Ritchie Rations                                                    | Fort Ritchie   | \$11,000  | Refrigerators, freezers, shelving, and SNAP/EBT infrastructure for this recently opened neighborhood grocery at Fort Ritchie, providing fresh food to a rural community with limited options.       |
| Wicomico     | Shore Acres Artisans & Farmers Market (Shore Ventures Group LLC)   | Fruitland      | \$150,000 | Covered 40x120 ft pavilion, enclosed cold storage hub, commercial refrigeration, and SNAP/EBT systems to establish a year-round farmers market and food access hub in Fruitland.                    |
| Wicomico     | CHESTERFIELD HEIRLOOMS LLC                                         | Pittsville     | \$110,000 | Walk-in refrigeration units, reach-in coolers and freezers, and a conditioning/packaging station to expand fresh food storage at this 12-acre farm stand serving a Wicomico County food desert.     |
| Worcester    | Snow Hill Food Rite (5RIVERS FOOD & GAS LLC)                       | Snow Hill      | \$90,000  | New refrigerated display cases, walk-in cooler upgrades, fresh produce display bins, and SNAP/EBT checkout infrastructure at this Snow Hill neighborhood grocery store.                             |
| Worcester    | Ocean City Organics                                                | Ocean City     | \$55,000  | Walk-in refrigerator/freezer expansion, additional upright refrigerators and freezers, and POS upgrades to increase fresh food storage capacity at this Ocean City organic grocery.                 |
