

Baltimore City**\$280,000**

Civic Works, Baltimore's Service Corps and an AmeriCorps organization, was founded in 1993 to strengthen Baltimore's communities through education, skills development and community service. Civic Works will use their funding to conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures based on audit findings in at least **36 homes**.

Baltimore City**\$ 160,000**

Green and Healthy Homes Initiative's (GHHI) is an organization that advocates for healthy, safe, and energy efficient homes. GHHI will use their funding to conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures (based on audit findings) in at least **21 homes**.

Baltimore City**\$367,787**

Healthy Neighborhoods Inc. (HNI) maintains and improves neighborhoods by supporting block projects that improve and enhance physical assets and neighborhood amenities, increasing property value, and building neighborhood confidence. HNI will use funding from MEA to complete cost-effective energy efficiency measures to approximately **10 buildings** located in Baltimore City.

Baltimore City**\$98,237**

Unity Properties is a subsidiary of Community Works, which provides safe and affordable housing to low-income families, seniors and people with disabilities. Using their funds from MEA, Unity Properties will conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures (based on audit findings) to approximately **13 row houses** on West Baltimore Street.

Central Region**\$328,500**

BlockChain Frontiers Foundation, Inc. (BFF) is a non-profit foundation located in Prince George's County that works with communities to develop sustainable principles, policies, and programs to enhance citizen health and housing and/or reduce bills. BFF will use their grant to conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures based on audit findings in at least **42 homes** located in Baltimore, Howard, and Montgomery Counties.

Central Region**\$365,500**

Civic Works, Inc. is division of Baltimore's Service Corps under AmeriCorps organization, works to strengthen Baltimore's communities through education, skills development and community service. Using their 2019 funding, Civic Works will conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures based on audit findings in at least **47 homes** located in Baltimore, Carroll, Cecil, Harford, Howard, and Montgomery Counties.

Central Region**\$338,000**

Community Action Council of Howard County, Inc. (CAC) of Howard County is a not for profit community action agency that manages grants and programs that benefit low income residents. CAC will use MEA funds to conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures (based on audit findings) in at least **43 homes** located in Baltimore County.

Central Region**\$135,000**

Green and Healthy Homes Initiative (GHHI) is an organization that advocates for healthy, safe, and energy efficient homes. GHHI will use their 2019 award to conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures (based on audit findings) in at least **17 homes** located in Baltimore County.

Central Region**\$100,000**

Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland (HFHMM) strives to provide a sustainable solution to the housing crisis affecting Montgomery and Prince George's Counties. Using 2019 funds, HFHMM will conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures (based on audit findings) in at least **13 homes** in Montgomery County.

Central Region**\$116,124**

Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna Inc. creates affordable housing opportunities throughout Harford and Cecil Counties by building, renovating and repairing homes in partnerships with the community. Using MEA funds, this organization will conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures based on audit findings in approximately **10 homes**, and fund the incremental costs of energy efficiency measures installed in approximately **5 to-be-constructed homes** in Harford and Cecil Counties.

Central Region**\$323,400**

SAFE Housing Inc. works to help economically disadvantaged people obtain or create safe, energy efficient housing. SAFE Housing will implement Whole Home/Whole Building upgrades to achieve a 10-year payback on installed measures. SAFE Housing will also service households that have been deferred due to health and safety concerns. Using MEA funds, SAFE Housing will conduct energy audits and install cost-effective energy efficiency measures to approximately **42 homes** in Carroll, Cecil, and Harford Counties.



Eastern Region **\$187,651**

Choptank Electric Cooperative is a member-owned electric distribution utility that serves over 52,406 residential, commercial and industrial accounts in parts of all nine counties of Maryland's Eastern Shore. Choptank Electric will use their 2019 grant to perform Whole Home/Whole Building upgrades that will include energy audits and installation of the most cost-effective energy efficiency and weatherization measures in at least **24 homes** located in Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester Counties.

Eastern Region **\$150,000**

Habitat for Humanity Choptank (HHC) empowers low-income households to improve their housing conditions. HHC has expanded from Talbot and Dorchester counties and has also diversified its projects beyond single family new construction to include rehabs as well as new construction multi-family builds. HHC will perform Whole Home/Whole Building upgrades that will include energy audits and installation of the most cost-effective energy efficiency and weatherization measures in at least **14 homes**, complete a comprehensive energy efficient renovation in one home, and fund the incremental costs of energy efficiency measures installed in approximately **5 to-be-constructed homes** in Dorchester and Talbot Counties.

Eastern Region **\$125,000**

SAFE Housing, Inc. works to help economically disadvantaged people obtain or create safe, energy efficient housing. SAFE Housing will implement Whole Home/Whole Building upgrades to achieve a 10-year payback on installed measures. SAFE Housing will conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency upgrades to at least **16 homes** in Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester Counties.

Southern Region **\$125,000**

Arundel Community Development Services, Inc. (ACDS) is a nonprofit established by Anne Arundel County to create and retain affordable housing opportunities locally, and to ensure the efficient delivery of community development services to those most in need. ACDS will use MEA funds to conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency measures (based on audit findings) in at least **16 homes** in Anne Arundel County.

Southern Region **\$400,000**

BlockChain Frontiers Foundation, Inc. (BFF) is a non-profit foundation located in Prince George's County that works with communities to develop sustainable principles, policies, and programs to enhance citizen health and housing and/or reduce bills. BFF will use their 2019 funds to conduct energy audits and install cost-effective energy efficiency measures based on audit findings in at least **51 homes** located in Anne Arundel, Calvert, Charles, Prince George's, and St. Mary's Counties.



Southern Region \$80,012

Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland (HFHMM) strives to provide a sustainable solution to the housing crisis affecting Montgomery and Prince George’s Counties. HFHMM will conduct energy audits and then install cost effective energy efficiency upgrades to at least **10 homes** in Prince George’s County.

Southern Region \$80,000

Housing Authority of St. Mary’s County (HASMCM) improves communities via beneficial services and programs and preserve affordable homeownership and rental housing for all citizens in need. HASMCM will use MEA funds to upgrade to Energy STAR appliances in up to **50 units** as well as replace fluorescent lightings in at least **20 units** located at the Gateways and Greenview Village in St. Mary’s County.

Southern Region \$218,000

SAFE Housing, Inc. works to help economically disadvantaged people obtain or create safe, energy efficient housing. SAFE Housing will implement Whole Home/Whole Building upgrades to achieve a 10-year payback on installed measures. SAFE Housing will use MEA funds to conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency upgrades to at least **28 homes** in Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary’s County.

Southern Region \$100,000

Town of North Beach is promoting a healthy and sustainable living through green initiatives and public education. The Town of North Beach will complete Whole Home/Whole Building upgrades consisting of performing an energy audit and then installing the most cost-effective energy efficiency and weatherization upgrades in at least **13 homes** located in Calvert County.

Southern Region \$250,000

United Communities Against Poverty (UCAP) advocates for communities facing deficiencies in education, affordable housing, economic stability and health care access. UCAP will use their 2019 funds to conduct energy audits and install cost-effective energy efficiency measures to approximately **32 homes** in Anne Arundel, Calvert, Charles, Prince George’s, and St. Mary’s Counties.

Western Region \$72, 289

Community Action Council of Howard County, Inc. (CAC) not for profit community action agency that manages many grants and programs that benefit low income residents. Using MEA funds, CAC will perform cost-effective weatherization of single-family houses as part of whole home upgrades that include an audit and energy efficiency and weatherization upgrades in at least **9 homes** in Hopewell Manor in Washington County.



Western Region

\$300,000

Frederick County Office of Sustainability and Environmental Resources advances practical solutions for protecting the environment, conserving energy, and sustainable living. Using MEA funds, Frederick County will conduct energy audits and install cost effective energy efficiency upgrades to at least **39 homes** via the Whole Home/Whole Building approach. They will also provide education on both energy efficiency measures and energy conservation behaviors that together can maximize electricity and fuel reductions and cost savings.

Western Region

\$100,000

SAFE Housing, Inc. works to help economically disadvantaged people obtain or create safe, energy efficient housing. SAFE Housing will implement Whole Home/Whole Building upgrades to achieve a 10-year payback on installed measures. Using MEA funds, SAFE Housing will conduct energy audits and install cost-effective energy efficiency upgrades to at least **13 homes** in Allegany, and Garrett Counties.
